REGISTRATION PLATFORM - OPENING ON 1ST FEBRUARY 2024

PROCEDURE FOR NEW ENTRIES

- 1. Go to: <u>https://www.endurogp.com/</u> then REGISTRATION / Riders
- 2. Create your account
- 3. Your account will be validated manually by the Promoter
- 4. Select the rounds you wish to enter
- 5. Once you pay for your entry, you will receive an automatic confirmation.

ENTRY FEES

- EUR 375.- for Male Rider.
- EUR 275.- for Women & Youth Rider.
- EUR 200.- for the Enduro Open Class.
- The renting fees of the transponders are included in the entry fee.

DEADLINES FOR ENTRIES

- Entries should be made 21 days before each event.
- For the entries made between 21 and 2 days before the administrative control of the Event, a fine of EUR 50.- (EUR 30.- for Enduro Open) will apply.
- Two days before the Event no entries will be accepted.







CANCELLATION POLICY

- Any cancellation certified by the rider's FMN, under presentation of a medical certificate, will be reimbursed (with a reduction of EUR 30.- as an administration fee) by the Promoter within 15 days after the event if the cancellation is confirmed within three days of the preliminary inspections.
- Riders cancelling their entries for any other reason will not be reimbursed.

CHANGE OF CATEGORY

During the Series, if a rider has already obtained points, he will be allowed to move to another category, but will not be allowed to score any Championship points in this new category.

FIM RIDERS LICENCES

Each Rider must contact its National Federation to obtain the correct FIM Enduro World Championships and Prizes Licence according to the planned participation (please note that CONU Championships licences will not be valid).

ENDURO TEAM LICENCE

This licence shall be associated to at least 1 Rider and it entitles the team to having their name in the official results. Requests need to be addressed to <u>licences@fim.ch</u> **before 15/03/2024** (each Rider can only be assigned to 1 Team). Form can be downloaded <u>HERE</u>.
